

Attestation for “As of Right” Exemption

Ontario’s “As of Right” exemption allows pharmacists and pharmacy technicians who are licensed and in good standing in another Canadian jurisdiction to practise in Ontario for up to six (6) months while they are completing their registration with the Ontario College of Pharmacists.

Conditions of Exemption

I, _____, wish to engage in the practise of pharmacy in Ontario as a _____ under the “As of Right” exemption for out-of-province pharmacy professionals.

I hereby attest that I meet all the conditions outlined in O. Reg 330/25: Exemption – Restricted Titles and declare the following:

1. I am registered in another Canadian jurisdiction and hold the equivalent of a certificate of registration in the practicing class in Ontario that authorizes me to provide patient care, without any terms, limitations or conditions.
2. I have not been refused registration by any regulatory authority in a Canadian jurisdiction within the two years preceding the submission of the application referred to in paragraph 5.
3. There has been no finding of professional misconduct, incompetence or incapacity about or against me because of a proceeding in relation to the profession of pharmacy.
4. I am not the subject of any current professional misconduct, incompetence or incapacity proceeding, or any similar proceeding related to the profession of pharmacy.
5. I have submitted an application to the Ontario College of Pharmacists for a certificate of registration prior to providing any professional services in Ontario.
6. I hold professional liability insurance coverage or benefit from professional liability insurance coverage or a similar protection that extends coverage to Ontario.
7. I will only provide professional services to residents of Ontario when I am physically present in Ontario.

Loss of Exemption

I, _____, understand that I will lose my ability to practice pharmacy in Ontario under the “As of Right” exemption if any of the following occur:

1. The Ontario College of Pharmacists rejects my application for a certificate of registration within the six (6) months following the day I first began providing professional services in Ontario.
2. The Ontario College of Pharmacists has not issued me a certificate of registration within the six (6) months following the day I first began providing professional services in Ontario.
3. I no longer satisfy a condition outlined under the “Conditions of Exemption” section above.

I understand that if any of the conditions listed under “Loss of Exemption” apply to me, I am no longer permitted to practise pharmacy in Ontario under the “As of Right” exemption and I must immediately cease to practise and cease to hold myself out as a pharmacy professional in Ontario.
