AS OF RIGHT PATHWAY

For pharmacists and pharmacy technicians already licensed in another Canadian province or territory who wish to immediately begin practicing in Ontario.

STEP 1: CONFIRM ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to practice under the As of Right rules, you must:

- ✓ Hold an active registration with an equivalent certificate (pharmacist or pharmacy technician authorized to provide patient care) in another Canadian jurisdiction
- ✓ Not been refused registration in another Canadian jurisdiction within the past two years
- ✓ Have no findings of professional misconduct, incompetence or incapacity
- ✓ Not be the subject of any current professional misconduct, incompetence or incapacity proceedings
- ✓ Hold professional liability insurance, applicable to practice in Ontario

STEP 2: CREATE AN ONLINE ACCOUNT WITH THE COLLEGE

- [Complete your registration application](#)
- Pay the [initial application fee](#) (see line 1)
- Submit [supporting documentation](#) of your evidence of identity and your citizenship or status in Canada

STEP 3: SUBMIT A COMPLETED ATTESTATION

- Complete and submit a signed [attestation](#)

STEP 4: PRACTICE FOR UP TO 6 MONTHS WHILE COMPLETING ALL COLLEGE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Use the relevant Ontario title while practicing (i.e., pharmacist or pharmacy technician)
- Be physically present in Ontario to provide services to Ontario residents
- ⚠ You must immediately stop practicing in Ontario if:
 - Your College registration application is rejected
 - You do not register with the College within six months
 - You do not continue to meet all the [eligibility criteria](#)

STEP 5: REGISTER WITH THE COLLEGE

Complete all [pharmacist registration requirements](#) or [pharmacy technician registration requirements](#) within the six-month window.
